Here's How...



Stop handshakes, and use non-contact greeting methods.



Children and staff will wash their hands for at least 20 seconds upon entering the classroom, and regularly throughout the day. Staff will supervise handwashing to ensure hands are properly washed.

There will be regular handwashing reminders.



Enhanced cleaning, sanitation, and disinfection of our schools. Frequently-touched surfaces will be cleaned and disinfected at least twice a day. All cleaning will be recorded for accuracy and for public health records.



Avoid touching your face, and cover your coughs and sneezes.

Screening



- Upon arrival, every staff member, student, and visitor (if applicable) must be screened prior to being admitted into our campuses.
- Everyone will be asked a few questions, including if they or their child(ren) have any COVID-19 symptoms or have travelled outside of Canada recently (including to the USA).

Training



- Staff will be provided with additional training specific to the new protocols provided by public health officials.
- Training will be ongoing as public health guidelines change and evolve.

Physical Distancing



- Physical distancing will be encouraged as much as possible (reasonable expectations will be established, based on the age of child and interactions with educators).
- Group activities between children will be limited (there will most likely be groupings or cohorts that stay together throughout the day).
- No unnecessary visitors at our schools (e.g., no tours during reopening phase).
- We may have to limit parents coming into our schools.
